

THE PURE PROMISE

- Arrive 15 minutes before scheduled start time wearing all required PPE (personal protection equipment).
- Review the provided tool list and arrive on-site, properly equipped.
- Thoroughly review the Scope of Work (SOW) and all supporting materials provided for the project.
 Any questions should be relayed to the Location Manager BEFORE the day of service.
- Be well-groomed and wear a collared shirt on all Pure Install jobs.
- Keep hygiene top of mind and do not emit any strong cologne, body, or cigarette smoke odor while on the job.
- Always act in a professional manner.
- Alcohol or drug use is strictly prohibited.
- Have ongoing, thorough communication with the Pure Install Location Manager before, during, and after the project.

- Submit an accurate invoice to your Pure Install Location Manager for work performed within 48 hours of completion of the job.
- Never use profanity or comments that might be interpreted as offensive on a job site.
- No cell phone use or music while on site unless for job related purposes.
- Contact Pure Install immediately with any changes to SOW, or problems on the job.
- Real-time communication is expected if issues arise.
- Proper clean-up of work area after project completion is required.
- Take multiple, in-focus photos before, during, and after services are provided. All damage should be documented and reported in real-time.
- The use of the Pure Install mobile app is required to confirm job was received, ETA, arrival, completion, and to upload photos and paperwork.
